A scholarship Committee shall be responsible for the administration of the Scholarship program including the selection of the scholarship recipients subject to the rules and regulations as specified by the Clark County United States Bowling (CCUSBC) Board of Directors.

The Scholarship Committee shall consist of three members who shall be appointed by the President of the CCUSBC with the approval of the Board of Directors.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

### Applicant must be:

- 1. A graduating senior, during the application year and must have a sufficient academic record to be accepted by an accredited college, junior college, technical institute or trade school'
- 2. An active CCUSBC Youth member, currently bowling in a CCUSBC Youth League and must have been a CCUSBC Youth bowler for at least the last two years.
- 3. A resident within the jurisdiction of the CCUSBC for at least the past two years.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA:**

- 1. Outstanding member of the CCUSBC.
- 2. Strong Tendencies in leadership.
- 3. Ability
- 4. Scholastic Achievements
- 5. Citizenship
- 6. Continued interest in bowling

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

- 1. Recipient may attend any institute of higher learning of his or her choice.
- 2. Scholarships, awarded by the CCUSBC shall be applied to tuition, however, the funds may be applied for books and fees if the CCUSBC Board of Directors should so determine.
- 3. When the scholarship holder has designated a school of choice, arrangements shall be made to transfer the scholarship amount to the appropriate school official.
- 4. In the event the scholarship holder is not enrolled in an accredited institution within one year from October 1<sup>st</sup> of the year the scholarship is awarded, it will be voided, unless it is for reasons deemed unavoidable or necessary by the Board of Directors. In such event, the Board of Directors may at its sole discretion, hold the scholarship for one additional year.
- 5. In the event a scholarship holder discontinues schooling before all funds have been utilized, the institution will be required to return any unused portion to the CCUSBC.
- 6. Three (3) letters of recommendation shall accompany all applications for this scholarship.
- 7. All applications must be submitted to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee of the CCUSBC, at the address shown at end of instructions, by April 1<sup>st</sup>, unless extended by the CCUSBC Board of Directors.
- 8. The Office Manager of the CCUSBC shall verify the membership status of all applicants.
- 9. Scholarship information and applications shall be sent to local bowling proprietors or managers and the CCUSBC.
- 10. The Scholarship Committee shall meet prior to the local (CCUSBC) annual meeting to review applications, and make selection of recipients.
- 11. Notification of the scholarship award shall be sent to the recipient with copies to the CCUSBC and other news media, as determined by the Association Manager.
- 12. A member of the CCUSBC shall present the scholarship, if possible. (by the Chairperson of the Committee at the Annual Meeting)
- 13. A scholarship certificate shall be printed on parchment suitable for framing or placing in a scrapbook.
