Section D. Term

The term for Directors is 3 years. The number of years in a term, the number of terms allowed and a stagger system are determined by the Board, adult members and Youth Representatives¹.

Section E. Resignation, Removal, and Vacancies

- 1. **Resignation.** A Board member may resign from the Board by providing written notice of resignation to the President or, in the case of the President, to the Board.
- 2. **Removal for Ineligibility.** A Board member who is no longer eligible to serve on the Board may be removed by a two-thirds vote of the Board when a quorum is present.
- 3. Removal for Cause. When a Board member is accused, in writing, of failure to properly perform the duties of their office or otherwise engaging in improper or unfair activities or conduct, the Board may conduct a meeting following the Removal Procedures in the Suspension and Reinstatement Chapter in the USBC Association Policy Manual. An appeal may be filed with USBC Headquarters within 15 days of the removal. Two-thirds written consent of the full Board is required to seek reelection and/or re-appointment to the Board.
- 4. **Vacancies.** The Board fills vacancies in the President's positon. All other vacancies are filled by the President, subject to approval by the Board.

Note: When filling Youth Director vacancies, please consult with the Youth Committee for their recommendations.
